BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a special session thereof, at the Court House of said County, on the 28th day of September, 1939, with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

"It appears to the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that a special election was held in and throughout Representative District No. 35, which includes Titus County, at the various voting places in said district, for the purpose of electing a State Representative for the 35th District, to fill out the unexpired term of Virgil A. Fielden, who resigned from that office. It appears that the returns of said election have been made by the election officers who held said election; and that from said returns it appears that the following votes were cast in Titus County:

Douglas Wright received	418 votes
Harry Gopaland received	334 votes
Frank Howell received	16 votes

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that Douglas Wright received a majority of votes in Titus County, Texas.
