

## SPECIAL SESSION - JANUARY 19, 1940

On this the 19 day of January, 1940, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, convened in special meeting at a Special Term thereof, with the following members of said Court present, to-wit:

constituting the entire Court, at which time the Judge presented for consideration an order. Commissioner Garrett made a motion that the order be passed. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gody, and the motion was carried by the following vote:

AYES: Commissioners Garrett, Gody, Brown and Lunsford.

NOES: None.

The Judge announced that the order had been passed.

The order is as follows:

## AN ORDER

DIRECTING THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES TO EVIDENCE  
 INTEREST OWING ON CERTAIN OUTSTANDING WARRANTS OF  
 TITUS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, there is outstanding against Titus County, Texas (among other warrants and coupons) Warrant Number Four (4) of an issue of \$30,000.00 dated March 10, 1928, which warrant is of the denomination of \$1,000.00 and matured April 10, 1934, attached to which warrant is one \$30.00 coupon which matured April 10, 1934 and the interest on said warrant and coupon calculated to December 10, 1939 amounts to \$264.63; and

WHEREAS, there are outstanding against Titus County, certain General Funding Warrants known as Titus County Funding Warrants, Series 1928-A numbered Two (2) to Twenty Three (23), both inclusive and certain coupons pertaining to said warrants have become delinquent and that the interest accumulated on said coupons from their respective maturities to December 10, 1939 amounts to \$1,161.60; and

WHEREAS, the warrants, coupons and interest above mentioned are fully described in an order passed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County on December 12, 1939, directing the issuance of Titus County General Refunding Bonds, dated December 10, 1939, in the amount of \$9,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the accumulated interest in the respective amounts of \$264.63 and \$1161.60 should be evidenced by a certificate executed by the officials of this county;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY,  
 TEXAS:

Section 1. That certificates be issued in the amount of \$264.63 and \$1161.60, respectively, for the purpose of evidencing the accrued interest hereinabove mentioned.

Section 2. That said certificates shall be in substantially the following form:

This is to certify that there is due the bearer hereof out of the General Fund of Titus County, Texas, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ being the accrued interest on \_\_\_\_\_ which is fully described in an order passed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas on December 12, 1939 directing the issuance of Titus County General Refunding Warrants, Series 1939, \$9,000.00.

This certificate is issued in accordance with an order passed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County on January 19, 1940.
