and passed the following order:

IT APPEARS TO THE COURT that it is to the best interest of Titus County and to its citizens and taxpayers that Titus County should purchase two motor road graders to be used in the construction, improvement and maintenance of the public roads of said county.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the court does hereby declare its intention to purchase two motor road graders for use in the construction, improvement and maintenance of the public roads of Titus County and to pay therefor by the issuance of time warrants in the maximum amount of not exceeding \$10,000 bearing interest at the rate of not exceeding 6% per annum with maximum maturity dated not later than 1952; and the County Judge is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be published accordingly.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner Lunsford and seconded by Commissioner Ody that it be passed, and upon the question being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners GARRETT, ODY and LUNSFORD voting AYE; and no one voting NO.
