SPECIAL SESSION, April 22, 1940

ORDER DECLARING INTENTION TO PURCHASE COURTHOUSE EQUIPMENT AND FURNITURE AND TO PAVE THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE

On this 22 day of April, 1940, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas convened in regular session at a special term of said court with all members thereof present, viz:

- C. T. Neugent, County Judge
- T. L. Garrett, Commissioner Precinct No. 1
- W. E. Gody, Commissioner Precinct No. 2
- Ernest Brown, Commissioner Precinct No. 3
- G. C. Lunsford, Commissioner Precinct No. 4
- A. B. Gilpin, County Clerk

There came on to be considered the matter of purchasing equipment and furniture for the newly remodeled and reconditioned courthouse and paving the courthouse square, and it appears to the court that such equipment and furniture should be purchased and installed and the courthouse square should be paved.

It is therefore ordered that the County Judge cause appropriate notice to that effect to be published inviting bids thereon and giving notice of intention to pay therefor by the issuance of not exceeding \$32,000 5% interest bearing time warrants maturing not later than 1950.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner Brown and seconded by Commissioner Garrett that it be passed, and upon the question being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners Garrett, Gody, Brown and Lunsford voting aye; and no one voting no.

For the purchase and installation of equipment and furniture for the newly remodeled and reconditioned courthouse of Titus County in Mount Pleasant, Texas;

Also for furnishing all materials and labor thereunto necessary and paving the courthouse square in Mount Pleasant, Texas.

Plans and specifications of the courthouse equipment and furniture, also plans and specifications for paving the courthouse square, may be seen at the office of the County Judge of Titus County and the rooms where such equipment and furniture are to be installed and the courthouse square to be paved may be inspected at said courthouse in Mount Pleasant, Texas.

The Commissioners Court reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive any and/or all technicalities.

It is the intention of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas to issue interest bearing time warrants for the purpose of paying for the heretofore described courthouse equipment and furniture and paving the courthouse square and the contracts therefor and the professional services incident thereto in the maximum amount of not exceeding \$32,000 bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum with maximum maturity date 1950.

SPECIAL SESSION - APRIL 23, 1940

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, met in a Called Session at the Court House in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on April 23, 1940, and the following members were present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown and seconded by Commissioner Lunsford and passed by the Commissioners Court that the County Treasurer be authorized to ship to J. R. Phillips Investment Co. upon their order \$25,000 Road Dist. #1 Bonds now held by the Sinking Fund of Titus County Road Bonds Series 4 at par and accrued interest, less service fee of 2 1/2% of the total amount equal to \$600.00, fee to be deducted at the time of delivery. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown and seconded by Commissioner Lunsford and passed by the Commissioners' Court that G. D. Jessup be authorized to prepare the legal papers and furnish services incident to the issuance of \$32,000 Titus County Courthouse & Jail Warrants. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.
