

SPECIAL SESSION - January 8, 1941

BE IT REMEMBERED That the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, met in Special Session on the 8th day of January, 1941, and the following members were present to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPROVAL OF BONDS:

County Treasurer,
D. C. Morgan/ submitted a bond of \$10,000.00 on January 2nd, which the court considered insufficient security for county funds and bonds in his possession. The Court required an additional bond of \$15,000.00, the two bonds totaling \$25,000.00. These two bonds were approved in open court by the Commissioners Court on the 8th day of January, 1941.

P. O. Wilhite, Tax Assessor-Collector, submitted a bond of \$6,000.00 on January 2nd, which the court considered insufficient security for the amount of tax money and county funds handled by him. The Court required an additional bond of \$19,000.00, the two bonds totaling \$25,000.00. These two bonds were approved in open court by the Commissioners Court on the 8th day of January, 1941.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner White to approve the bond of Bruce Rountree, Public Weigher, Pre. Nos. 2 & 8. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, to approve the bond of Aubrey Redfearn, Deputy Constable, Pre. 2 & 8. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.
