IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY REPORTS AND EXPENSE ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner White, to approve the monthly reports of Susie Brabham, Home Demonstration Agent, and Jas. W. McConn., County Agent. All voted "Aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING ANNUAL REPORT OF E. J. NARRAMORE:

The Annual Report of E. J. Narramore, Constable, Pre. 6, was approved by the Court, unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF ADVERTISING FOR BIDS ON ROAD MACHINERY:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, to authorize the County Judge to advertise for bids for a road grader and a tractor. All voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING CONCESSION TO MISS JOHNNIE LEE TAYLOR IN COURT HOUSE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin and seconded by Commissioner Nugent, to give a concession to Miss Johnnie Lee Taylor in the Court House. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING AUDITOR'S REPORT FOR 1940:

Motion was made by Commissioner Nugent and seconded by Commissioner Garrett to approve the Annual Auditor's Report of the West Audit Company for Titus County for 1940. All voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF SELLING OLD MULE GRADER:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Nugent, to authorize Commissioner Goodwin to sell one old discarded county mule grader at the best price obtainable. All voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF REFUNDING FEDERAL LAND BANK TAXES ASSESSED IN ERROR:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to refund \$63.74 to the Federal Land Bank on taxes paid by it, which were assessed in error on the Johnson-Ping Survey, 69 acres of this land is in Franklin County. All voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELING WARRANT ISSUED TO FEDERAL LAND BANK IN ERROR:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to cancel Warrant No. 5983, issued to the Federal Land Bank on December 31, 1940, out of the Road & Bridge Fund for \$31.88, which was in error. All voted "aye" and the motion carried and the warrant was ordered canceled.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYING PAULINE DALE IN TITUS COUNTY WELFARE OFFICE:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, to employ Pauline Dale as clerk in the Titus County Welfare Office, for a period of 16 days a month, at a salary of \$17.50, to be paid out of the General County Fund. All voted "aye" and the motion carried.
