and the following matters came before the court, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF PREPARING A COUNTY BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1942.

Motion was made by Garrett and seconded by Goodwin to employ Mr. Lotus Hamrick to prepare a county budget for the year 1942 at a contract price for \$100.00 to be paid on completion of the budget, and its acceptance by the court, out of an available cash fund of the county; the motion was submitted by the County Judge to a vote and the following members voted "Aye" Garrett, Goodwin and White. There was no dissenting vote as Commissioner Nugent was not present. Motion carried and Lotus Hamrick was employed according to above terms.
