IN THE MATTER OF DIVIDING LATERAL ROAD FUNDS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin, Seconded by Commissioner Nugent that county funds collected in Lateral Road Funds received be divided among the Commissioners Precincts in four equal parts; Motion submitted to the court by County Judge, all Commissioners voted "aye", and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYMENT OF CLERICAL HELD AT THE WELFARE OFFICE.

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin, Seconded by Nugent to employ Frances Smelser as clerk at the Welfare Office under direction of Mrs. Jessie Johnson, welfare worker, at a salary of \$20.00 per month to be paid out of a cash fund. Motion submitted by County Judge, Ed Dickson, all voted aye and the motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business of this Court Motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner White, seconded by Garrett. All voted "Aye" and the Court adjourned.
