

Special Session-October 28, 1941

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners Court met in Special Session October 28, 1941, at the Court house in the City of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLING WARRANT NO. 7507

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett, seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to cancel Gen. Co. Fund Warrant No. 7507 in amount of \$17.83 to Proctor Drug Store and to issue in lieu 1 warrant for \$10.83 Gen. Co. and 1 warrant for \$7.00 Gen. Co. For purpose of applying part in payment of taxes. All voted "aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF ISSUING WARRANTY TO SHERIFF FOR BOARD BILL

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin, seconded by White to advance the sheriff a warrant for board bill in the amount of \$375.00. and authorize the clerk to issue warrant not later than Oct. 31, for the purpose of the sheriff selling his warrant to St. Louis S. W. Railway so that it can be applied on their taxes. All commissioners voted "Aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYMENT OF AN ENGINEER TO WORK UP A W. P. A. MASTER PROJECT

Motion was made by Comm. Goodwin seconded by Comm. Nugent that C. A. Falter be employed at \$125.00 to prepare necessary data for obtaining a County wide master W.P.A. project. All voted "Aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the court, the court adjourned to meet in regular session on November 10, 1941, upon motion by Commissioner White seconded by Goodwin, all voted "aye".
