WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of TitusCounty, Texas, has heretofore on the 13th. day of December, 1941, passed an order authorizing the issuance of Titus County Road and Bridge Time Warrants, Series 1941, \$25,000.00, bearing interest at the rate of four and one-half (41%) per cent, per annum, and has provided therein the method of completing the delivery of said warrants from time to time in installments; and

WikkEAS, errangements have been made with First National Bank, Mt. Pleasant, Texas, to assemble duly approved claims and accounts against the County of persons furnishing materials or performing services or labor in connection with the County's construction program in which the United States Government is cooperating with the County through the Works Progress Administration
