at which time motion was made by Commissioner Garrett, Seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, that to pay the interest on \$25,000.00 TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ REFUNDING BONDS to be authorized on May 15, 1942, in accordance with thirty days' published notice being given, and subject only to a petition of 10% of the qualified voters restraining the issuance of such proposed refunding Bonds not being presented to this Court by May 15, 1942, and to create a sinking fund sufficient to discharge them as they mature, a tax of two (.02) cents on the One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars' assessed valuation of all taxable property in the County of Titus, Texas, is hereby levied for the year 1942, out of the Constitutional Fifteen (15 $\frac{1}{2}$) Cents Road and Bridge Fund Tax of said County, and said tax shall be assessed and collected, and there shall be calculated each year, while any of said bonds or interest thereon are outstanding and unpaid, whatever rate of tax is necessary to provide current interest and the required amount of the principal for such year, or a proportionate part thereof, and for each of said years a tax at such rate within the rate permitted by the Constitution is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected and that such taxes when collected shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes named.
