IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING TAX COLLECTOR & ASSESSOR TO MAKE REFUND ON 1939 TAX PAYMENT OF  
MRS. MILLIE DUKE  
TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT:

I hereby request authority to make refund on the 1939 tax payment of Mrs. Millie Duke for the following reasons:

On September 11, 1941, on receipt #70, Mrs. Duke paid the above taxes but for some reason such tax was not properly credited. Then on January 3, 1942 Mrs. Duke paid the same tax again. The error was not discovered until the redemption receipts were returned from Austin.

According to instructions from the Comptroller's Office the state tax cannot be refunded but the Commissioners' Court has the right to grant authority for a refund of the County's part of such tax. The amount of tax to be refunded is as listed below:
