REGULAR SESSION- AUGUST 10, 1942

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 10th. day of August, 1942 the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, met in Regular Session at the Court House in Mt. Pleasant, with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had-to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and Seconded by Commissioner Nugent to approve the monthly accounts as recorded in Volume 6, minutes of Accounts Allowed, all members voted "Aye"

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS FOR July, 1942.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and Seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to approve the monthly expense accounts of Floyd Keith, Co. Clerk, P. O. Wilhite, Tax Collector, E. W. Albright Sheriff, J. A. Glass, District Clerk, Charlie W. Robinson, Justice of Peace, J. A. Brooks, Constable and Traylor Russell, District Attorney as same were reported, all members voted "Aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYING JNO. M. BIGGERSTAFF TO PREPARE BUDGET FOR YEAR 1943 AND AUDIT BOOKS FOR YEAR 1942.

Motion was made by Commissioner Nugent and seconded by Commissioner Garrett that the Comm. Court employ Jno. M. Biggerstaff of Sulphur Springs, Texas to prepare budget for the year 1943 and make annual audit of the records of Titus County for the year 1942, covering all officers and offices of said County in same.

For and in consideration for the services rendered the County Jno. M. Biggerstaff is to be paid the sum of \$450.00 when said budget and audit is completed and accepted by the Commissioners Court of Titus County.

Upon roll call by County Judge Ed Dickson all commissioners voted AYE. Motion declared carried by County Judge.

IN THE MATTER OF PROVIDING A CAR FOR COUNTY DEFENSE CHAIRMAN

On motion of Comm. Garrett seconded by Goodwin the sum of \$250.00 is to be appropriated for purpose of exchange of car owned by Titus County for car owned by Irvin-Sandlin. And it is further ordered that title to this car be transferred to B. A. Watson, Chairman County Defense Council for service in defense work, as it is necessary that title of car be vested in him in order that he can secure tires and tubes by priority. All voted "Aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AIDING IN OPERATIONS OF TITUS COUNTY DEFENSE GUARD:

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett seconded by Comm. Nugent that Titus County Commissioners Court appropriate the sum of \$35.00 per month payable out of the operation or some other cash fund, to the Texas Defense Guard, and deliver check to Allen Wilhite, Company Clerk, Mt. Pleasant, Texas. This is an essential measure for purpose of protection and defense, rated as an emergency. Motion submitted by County Judge and Commissioners Garrett, Nugent and Goodwin voted "Aye"; Commissioner White Absent not voting. The motion was declared carried.

There being no further business before the court, motion was made by Comm. Nugent and seconded by Comm. Garrett to adjourn. All voted "Aye".
