BE IT REMEMBERED that the County Commissioners Court met in Special Session on this the 28th. day of December, 1942 with the following members presents, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$20.00 PER YEAR TO THE SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin that the Court appropriate the sum of \$20.00 to cover the expenses for the year 1943 for the Soil Conservation Service. Motion submitted by the County Judge, all voted "Aye" and the motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING THE TAX LEVY FOR 1942.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett seconded by Goodwin to mand the levy made in regular session Sept. 18, 1942, at this time the levy was made for 3¢ on \$100.00 for Gen Co. Special purposes in order to clarify the purpose of this fund we amend it to read for the purpose of retiring old Gen. Co. Script.

CORRECTING
IN THE MATTER OF TAX LEVY COVERING COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 16.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garrett seconded by Goodwin that the tax levy covering Common School District No. 16 (Overland) be changed from \$1.00 to 75¢. This levy was set at 75¢ by the court but in copying the minutes an error was made which showed the levy to be \$1.00 on a hundred dollar valuation. Motion submitted all voted "aye", and the motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin Seconded by Commissioner Nugent to adjourn, all voted "Aye".
