IN THE MATTER OF SELECTING A PURCHASING AGENT FOR COUNTY:

Motion was made by Commissioner Nugent and seconded by Commissioner Banks to make Ed Dickson, County Judge, purchasing agent for the supplies for the Courthouse and Jail. All members voted "aye" and the motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER.

Motion by Nugent seconded by Banks to appoint Dr. John M. Ellis Co. health officer for the year 1943. All members voted "Aye" and the motion carried.

 IN THE MATTER OF SETTING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SALARIES

Motion by Nugent seconded by Commissioner Taylor to set County Commissioners annual Salary at \$1400.00 to be paid \$116.66 per month. Motion submitted by the County Judge and all members voted "Aye", motion carried unanimously.

 IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING A. J. GAUTNEY REPAIRMAN FOR COURT HOUSE & JAIL FOR 1943.

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin seconded by Commissioner Nugent to appoint A. J. Gautney as repairman for Courthouse & Jail at a salary of \$100.00 to be paid out of the Permanent Improvement Available fund. Motion was put before the Court by the County Judge and all members voted "Aye".

 IN THE MATTER OF KEEPING COUNTY AND PRECINCT OFFICERS ON FEE BASES FOR 1943;

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin and seconded by Commissioner Nugent to compensate all county and precinct officers, exclusive of Registrars of Vital Statistics, County Surveyors, Notaries Public, by fees earned by them in the official duties.

The following order was passed.

"On this the 11th. day of January, 1943, came on to be considered the matter of keeping County and Precinct Officers on a fee basis, or on a salary. It appearing to the Commissioners' Court that the population of Titus County, according to the last Federal Census, is under twenty thousand, and that it be to the best interest of the County to remain on the fee system for the year 1943, Commissioner Goodwin made a motion that the Court adopt an order to that effect. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Nugent. The County Judge put the motion before the Court, and all members voting "Aye", the motion carried unanimously, and the order was passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF SETTING EX-OFFICIO AND SALARIES FOR THE YEAR 1943:

Motion was made by Commissioner Goodwin seconded by Nugent, to set the ex-officio and salaries of officials for the year 1943 ONLY as follows:
