\$1,600.00 Liberty Hill Common School District #22, 5% bonds, dated October 10, 1927, and maturing October 10, 1947; \$1,600.00 Farmer's Academy Common School District #6, 5% bonds, dated June 20, 1929, and maturing June 20, 1949; \$900.00 Oak Grove Common School District #10, 5% bonds, dated September 10, 1929, and maturing September 10, 1949; \$700.00 Cypress Common School District #25, 5% bonds, dated July 20, 1928, and maturing July 20, 1948; \$700.00 New Hope Common School District #33, 5% bonds, dated October 10, 1927, and maturing October 10, 1947.
