

SPECIAL SESSION - JULY 23, 1944

BE IT REMEMBERED, That the Commissioners Court of Titus County met in Special Session this the 23 day of July 1944 with the following members present viz: Ed Dickson, County Judge, Commissioners L. C. Banks, E. E. Nugent and C. H. Goodwin and Floyd Keith, County Clerk, proceedings were as follows, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF LETTING CONTRACT FOR COUNTY AUDIT.

Motion by Commissioner Nugent seconded by Commissioner Banks that the Court accept proposal and bid of the W. F. Turner Company to prepare the County Budget for the year 1945 and make an audit of the County's finances, all departments, with exception of Common School District Bonds and accounts. The consideration to be paid him for this service to be \$585.00 net, payable out of the General Fund. All members voted Aye, Motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR STUCCOING THE COUNTY COURT HOUSE.

Commissioner Nugent made a motion which was seconded by Com. Banks that the Commissioners Court advertise that they will consider bids for stuccoing the outside walls of the court house building. Motion submitted by County Judge with result as follows: Commissioners Nugent, Banks and Goodwin voted "AYE" Commissioner Taylor was absent, not voting, County Judge declared the motion carried.
