IN THE MATTER OF CONDEMNING AND CLOSING OLD HIGHWAY NO. 271

Motion by Commissioner Wilson seconded by Commissioner Banks to condemn and close the old highway 271 northwest of Talco beginning 50 yards South of slough bridge end extending to Franklin County line, due to the fact that Franklin County Commissioners Court has passed an order closing their portion of the old highway and are salvaging the bridge adjacent to Titus County line, gravel is unsafe on said road and this action is taken as a measure of safety and to eliminate a hazard. Motion put to a vote all vote "Aye", motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING BOND OF TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR

Motion by Commissioner Fleming, seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to reduce the bond of W. W. Mason, Tax Assessor-Collector from \$25,000 to \$12,000, all voted "Aye", motion carried.
