SPECIAL SESSION-January 31, 1945

BE IT REMEMBERED, that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, met in Special session at the court house in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on this the 31st. day of January, 1945, with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF SETTING SALARY OF A. J. GAUTNEY AT \$86.00 AND EMPLOYING WAT HOWARD AS HELPER FOR REPAIRMAN.

Motion was made by Commissioner Fleming and seconded by Commissioner Wilson to amend the court's order passed at the January term, setting the salary of A. J. Gautney, as repairmen for the court house, and to correct the amount to be paid him to read \$86.00 per month instead of \$110.00 and that the sum of \$24.00 per month shall be paid to Watt Howard who is to be employed as helper to Court House Repairment, and this order is to be retroactive to January 1, 1945. The court considers this adjustment of wages necessary in order to show the actual net amount of A. J. Gautney's wages in the above employment, and to correct any impression that the court is paying him a full salary of \$110.00 and paying his helper in addition, Heretofore A. J. Gautney has been paying all his helpers out of his monthly wages.

Motion was submitted for vote; Commissioners Fleming, Wilson and Goodwin, Vote "Aye", Commissioner Banks was absent, motion declared carried.

There being no further business motion was made by Commissioner Fleming, seconded by Commissioner Wilson to adjourn, all members voted "Aye", motion carried.
