Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in Special Session at the Courthouse in Mt. Pleasant with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES SUSTAINED IN ACCIDENT ON HIGHWAY TO CALVIN H. PERKINS AND LAVERNE PERKINS.

Motion by Comm. Fleming seconded by Comm. Banks to pay Calvin H. and Lavern Perkins the sum of \$210.00 Two hundred-ten and 00/100 Dollars in settlement of all claims for damages and injuries sustained in an accident on old highway Number 67 East of Winfield on account of bridge washed out from flood damage. The alleged date of accident occurred on April 21st. 1945.

Motion put to vote. Commissioner Fleming, Banks, Wilson and Goodwin voted Aye-Motion declared carried.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, Calvin H. Perkins and wife, Lavern Perkins for and in consideration of Two Hundred ten and No/100 Dollars (\$210.00) cash in hand paid by the County of Titus, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do;

acknowledge full settlement of all claims that may have arisen against the said county by reason of an accident occurring on Old Highway #67 just East of Winfield, Texas on the 21st. day of April, 1945. Said accident having happened by reason of our car having run into a ditch so created by high waters.

We do further release and discharge any further claim that we might have for damages for personal injuries or otherwise caused by reason of said accident. We hereby admit that this is a fair and just and complete settlement of all damages done to us by personal injuries and/or otherwise and it is our intentions by this instrument to give a full and complete release to said County.
