IN THE MATTER OF SETTING SALARIES OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Motion by Fleming, seconded by Goodwin to amend order dated Jan. 8 setting salaries of County Commissioners at fourteen hundred dollars (\$1400.00) a year and same is to read by this order salary be fixed for months of July, Aug. Sept. Oct. Nov and Dec. 1945 at the rate of \$1800. per annum to be paid monthly out of Road & Bridge fund of County. Motion before court all members voted "Aye", Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING COUNTY BUDGET.

Motion by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Banks to amend the County Budget which was adopted setting \$5600.00 as salaries for year 1945 of County Commissioners, and to raise same so as to provide \$3600.00 for the 6 months period July to Dec. 31.
