house Bill Number 555 of the recent acts of the 49th Legislature at its regular session, provided that "official shorthand reporter of each judicial District Court, Civil or Criminal shall receive a salary of not less than \$2400 per annum and not more than \$3750 per annum. Said salary shall be fixed and determined by the District Judges of Judicial Districts, Civil or Criminal, who shall enter an order in the Minutes of the Court, in each County of the District, which shall be a public record and open for public inspection, stating specifically the amount of salary to be paid said reporter. The District Judge shall file a copy of said order with each Commissioners' Court of the District, and

It appearing to the Court, that on account of the High Cost of living expenses, that the present salary of \$2700.00 to the official Court reporter is not sufficient to meet the increase of living expenses, and District Judge of said 76th Judicial District of Texas in his opinion deems that the official court reporter for said 76th Judicial District should have an increase of salary and that after September 1st, 1945, the annual salary of said reporter

should be the sum of \$3,000.00 per annum, payable monthly, and pro-rated out and among the 5 counties and payable respectively to-wit:

Titus County,	the sum of	\$73.03
Marion County	the sum of	\$62.50
Morris County	the sum of	\$41.55
Camp County	the sum of	\$41.55
Franklin County	the sum of	\$31.37

So it is the order of the Court that the said J. B. Redfearn official Court Reporter for said District and his successor in office until changed or modified shall be paid the aforesaid sum and divided and apportioned among the counties as herein above set out.

A copy of this order shall be spread upon the minute of this Court and a copy furnished to the Commissioners Court of the County.
