IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING DISCOUNT ON TAXES.

The Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, in regular session, September 10, 1945, with all the members of said court present, when Commissioner Banks made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, to adopt the following resolution:

"Be it resolved by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, that in conformity with Senate Bill No. 402, 46th Leg. Regular Session, that any taxpayer owing taxes on any property located in Titus County, Texas, real, personal, or mixed, to the State of Texas, Titus County, or mixed, to the State of Texas, Titus County, or any common school district, shall be allowed a discount of 3% on said taxes provided that the same are paid during the month of October for the year in which said taxes are assessed; and shall be allowed a discount of 2% on said taxes provided the same are paid during the month of November for the year in which said taxes are assessed; and shall be allowed a discount of 1% on said taxes provided the same are paid in the month of December in the year for which said taxes are assessed.

Be it further resolved that no discount shall be allowed except such as is provided herein, and that no discount shall be allowed where the taxpayer splits the payment of the taxes as is provided by law.

Be it further resolved that this order shall be effective on and from the 10th day of September, A. D. 1945."

Motion submitted, all voted "Aye", Motion carried.
