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IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING TRACTOR

It appearing to the Court that it is to the best interest of Titus County and to its citizens that Titus County purchase road machinery for use in the construction, improvement and maintenance of public roads of Titus County, as hereinafter described;

IT IS, THEREFORE ORDERED that the Court hereby declare its intention to purchase  
One Crawler Type, Diesel Powered Tractor of not less than 50 H.P.

And to pay therefor, if any bid is accepted, in part by a trade-in of one second hand Allis-Chalmers, Model W. S. Tractor, and it will be the intention of the Commissioners Court to make payment for the additional amount of any contract in connection therewith by the issuance of time warrants in the maximum amount of not exceeding \$4,000.00 bearing interest at a rate not exceeding 4% per annum, with a maximum maturity date not exceeding 8 years from the date of said warrants.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner Fleming, and seconded by Commissioner Banks, that it be passed, and upon the question being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners Banks, Fleming, Wilson, and Goodwin voting "AYE" and no one voting "NO".
