IN THE MATTER OF LEASING OFFICES FOR ARMY RECRUITING SERVICE:

Motion by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Comm. Goodwin to authorize County Judge Ed Dickson, to execute a lease on behalf of Titus County Commissioners Court to the U. S. War Department of the two south offices on west side of fourth floor of Courthouse for the purpose of army recruiting Service for consideration of fifteen dollars per month to provide for utility expense.

Motion was submitted by County Judge. Commissioners Wilson, Goodwin and Banks, voted "Aye", Commissioner Fleming absent, Not voting. Motion declared carried.
