BE IT REMEMBERED, that the Commissioners Court of Titus County met in Regular Session at the Courthouse in Mt. Pleasant with the following members present, to-wit:

Be it remembered that the Commissioners court of Titus County met in regular session at the regular term Nov. 12, 1945. No proceedings were transacted on account of the day being observed as a holiday and the various offices at Courthouse closed. Motion was made by Commissioner Fleming and seconded by Commissioner Goodwin to recess court until Tuesday Nov. 13 at 9 A. M. Motion was submitted. All voted "Aye" and motion declared carried.

IN THE MATTER OF FEDERAL PRISONERS:

Motion by Commissioner Goodwin that County Judge Ed Dickson and Aubrey Redfearn, Sheriff, be authorized to execute a contract with the Federal Government through United States Marshall of Eastern District of Texas, whereby the County agrees to receive Federal prisoners and to provide for their safe keeping, care and subsistence and quarters in the County jail at Mt. Pleasant for a term of 3 years at a rate of 60 cents a day. Motion was submitted by the County Judge and all commissioners voted "Aye", motion declared carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS
