Commissioner Banks presented an order and moved its adoption. Commissioner Goodwin seconded said motion. The order was duly read and the County Judge put the motion to a vote and all commissioners voted "AYE", none voting "NOES." WHEREAS, the above and foregoing accounts being properly chargeable to the Road and Bridge Fund of Titus County and that said accounts are just;

NOW, THEREFORE,

it is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County that each and all of the above and foregoing accounts be and they are in all things approved and ordered paid by the issuance of scrip warrants by the County Clerk of Titus County to be appropriately registered and to be paid out of current revenues and/or automobile and motor vehicles registrations for 1926 apportioned to the Road and Bridge Funds of said Titus County, Texas;

and that such automobile and motor vehicle registration funds for 1946 are hereby set apart and pledged to and for the payment of such scrip warrants.
