IN THE MATTER OF EXEPTING COUNTY & PRECINCT OFFICERS ON A FEE BASIS FOR YEAR 1946.

Commissioner Fleming made a motion to employ W. M. Harper, the motion was lost for want of a second. Motion by Commissioner Goodwin and seconded by Commissioner Wilson to approve application of A. J. Gautney at a salary of \$100.00 per month, payabletouthof the Fermenant improvement Available Fund. Motion was put for vote and carried unanimously. Motion declared carried.

IN THE MATTER OF EMPLOYING ASSISTANT REPAIRMAN

Howard as Assistant Court House Repairmen at a salary of 334.00 per month. Motion was
