IN THE MATTER OF LOST OR DESTROYED GENERAL FUND WARRANT

Motion was made by Commissioner Banks and seconded by Commissioner Wilson to order General Fund Warrant No. 2743 dated Nov. 11, 1945 issued to Mrs. James Adams for the amount of \$5.00 to be cancelled on records of County Clerk and County Treasurer and notice given all concerned to stop payment on same. This on account of claim that this warrant was lost or destroyed in fact had never been received by the payee. It is further ordered that the County Clerk be authorized to issue a warrant for like amount in lieu of cancelled warrant but to make same payable to Mrs. Edith Adams, who is in fact Mrs. James Adams and entitled to be paid for service as clerk in election.

Motion submitted and passed by following vote: Commissioners Banks, Wilson and Goodwin voted "AYE" Commissioner Fleming was absent.
