AND IT FURTHER APPEARS that, in consideration of full payment, the above described claims have been assigned to the First National Bank, Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with request that payment be made direct to said assignee.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

That the hereinbefore described claims, and each of them, are hereby approved, allowed and ordered paid in the manner hereinafter set out.

Also, the assignments thereof to the First National Bank, Mt. Pleasant, Texas, are hereby approved.

And that payment thereof, to the extent of \$12,000.00, be made by the execution and delivery to said assignee Bank \$12,000.00 of the hereinbefore mentioned Titus County 4% Road and Bridge Warrants, dated August 15, 1946; and a memorandum of approved claim for the odd amount balance of \$857.17, to be included in a subsequent installment delivery of such warrants.

The County Judge and the County Clerk and the County Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such \$12,000.00 warrants as herein set out; and the County Clerk to issue memorandum of the above mentioned \$857.17 balance approved claim.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner Fleming and seconded by Commissioner Banks that it be passed, and upon the question's being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners Banks, Fleming and Wilson voting AYE; and no one voting NO.
