BE IT REMEMBERED That the Commissioners Court met in Special Session at the Court House in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, on the 25rd day of December, 1946 with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF LOAN TO ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND:

Motion was made by Commissioner Fleming, Seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, authorizing the County Treasurer to pay warrant drawn on Permanent Improvement Available Fund, payable to Titus County Road and Bridge Fund for the sum of \$3200.00, which sum will be a loan and evidenced by a warrant drawn on Road and Bridge Fund and payable May 15, 1947 to the Permanent Improvement Available Fund. Motion put to vote by County Judge. All voted "Aye" Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FLOYD D. THOMAS ACCOUNT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Wilson, Seconded by Commissioner Banks to pay Floyd D. Thomas the sum of \$50.00 to help defray funeral expense of Mrs. _____ Goodwin who died in Sanatorium Hospital. Motion submitted by County Judge and carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF RAISING SALARY FOR COURT REPORTER:

Mount Pleasant, Texas
December 23, 1946

WHEREAS, the official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, J. B. Redfearn of Mount Pleasant, Texas is at present drawing a salary of \$3000.00 per year (or \$250.00 per month) apportioned among the 5 counties of the District, and

WHEREAS, due to the rapid advance in price of food commodities and other increase in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advances of living cost, and the court deems that the salary should be increased \$25.00 per month or an increase of \$300.00 yearly, making a salary of \$3300.00 per year, or \$275.00 per month, commencing January 1st, 1947, and to be apportioned and pro-rata among the 5 counties on per month basis as follows:

Camp County	\$45.60
Franklin County	34.82
Marion County	88.75
Morris County	45.60
Titus County	80.43
