IN THE MATTER OF LOAK TO ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND:

Motion was made by Commissioner Fleming, Seconded by Commissioner Goodwin, authorizing the County Treasurer to pay warrant drawn on Permanent Improvement Available Fund, payable to Titus County Road and Bridge Fund for the sum of \$5200.00, which sum will be a loan and exidenced by a warrant drawn on Road and Bridge Fund and payable May 15, 1947 to the Permanent Improvement Available Fund. Motion put to wote by County Judge. All woted "Aye" Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FLOYD D. THOMAS ACCOUNT:

Metion was made by Commissioner Wilson, Seconded by Commissioner Banks to pay Floyd D. Thomas the sum of \$50.00 to help defray funeral expense of Mrs. Goodwin who died in Sanatorium Hoapital. Motion submitted by County Judge and carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF RAISING SALARY FOR COURT REPORTER:

Mount Pleasant, Texas December 23, 1946

WHEREAS, the official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, J. B. Redfearn of Mount Pleasant, Texas is at present drawing a salary of \$5000.00 per year (or \$250.00 per month) apportioned among the 5 counties of the District, and

WHEREAS, due to the rapid advance in price of food commodities and other increase in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advances of living cost, and the court deems that the saiary should be increased \$25.00 per month or an increase of \$300.00 yearly, making a salary of \$3300.00 per year, or \$275.00 per month, commencing January 1st, 1947, and to be apportioned and pro-rata among the 5 sounties on per month basis as follows:

Camp County	\$45.60
Franklin County	34.62
Marion County	68.75
Morris County	45.60
Titus County	80.43
