N. Burt & Company at their bid of par and accrued interest.

THERE CAME ON TO BE CONSIDERED the returns of an election which was held on the 17th day of May, 1947, in and throughout Titus County, Texas, upon the following proposition:

On the question of the issuance of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) Dollars Hospital Bonds and the levy of a tax in payment thereof.

And it appears affirmatively to the court that said election was regularly ordered, and that notice thereof was regularly given for the time and in the manner provided by law, and that said election was regularly held, and that only duly qualified electors who own taxable property in said county and who had duly rendered the same for taxation voted thereat, and that returns of said election was regularly made to this Court, and from said returns it appears that 600 votes were cast at said election, of which number there were cast:

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF 159 votes;

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. 441 votes;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

That said proposition for the issuance of hospital bonds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) Dollars was defeated by 142 votes.

The foregoing order was read and it was moved by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Ponder that it be passed, and upon the question's being called it was unanimously passed, Commissioners Jones, Moore, Hanks and Ponder voting Aye; and no one voting No.
