 IN THE MATTER OF PAYMENT OF RENT TO CITY OF TALCO:

We, the Mayor and City Commission, of The City of Talco, Texas, hereby ask that you present to the Commissioners Court of Titus County at your next regular meeting the following:

The City of Talco, Texas has been furnishing Mr. Powell, Deputy Sheriff of Titus County, living quarters in the City Hall at Talco, has been furnishing all utilities, has been furnishing an office for Justice of Peace of this Precinct, without any charges, and have also been furnishing a jail house for prisoners arrested here without any charges.

We, the Mayor and Commissioners, think that we are entitled to at least enough pay from the County to at least defray expenses of utilities and upkeep of the jail house, and we hereby ask that you present this before the next meeting held and ask that the Court authorize payment out of County Funds in the sum of at least \$25.00 per month to The City of Talco, Texas. Effective May 1, 1947.

We believe that the amount we have ask for is fair and just and is about one half the amount that we could rent these spaces for to be used as offices.
