IN THE MATTER OF REPAIRING COURT HOUSE ROOF:

IN THE MATTER OF ENTERING INTO CONTRACT WITH U.S. GOVERNMENT RENTING OFFICES FOR RECRUITING:

into a contract with the United States Government for renting to the Army Recruiting Services
two rooms on the fourth floor of the Court House. Motion was made by CommissionerMoore and
Seconded by Commissioner Ponder that the County Judge be directed and authorized to enter into
a rental contract with the Army Recruiting Service for the renting of two rooms on the 4th
floor of the Court House for a term of 1 year beginning July 1, 1947 through June 30, 1948 in
consideration of the sum of \$180.00. Upon being put to a vote, said motion carried unanimously.
