

REGULAR SESSION-September 8, 1947

BE IT REMEMBERED That the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in Regular Session on the 8th day of September, 1947, at the Court House of said County, in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with members present at follows, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Moore to approve the monthly accounts as same appear of record in Volume 8, Minutes of Accounts Allowed. Upon being put to a vote, said motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING TAX-ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR'S COMMISSIONS EARNED:

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones, Seconded by Commissioner Moore to approve the monthly report of commissions earned for the month of August of W. W. Mason, Tax Assessor-Collector. Motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Mankins that the monthly expense accounts of the following officers be approved, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY REPORT OF COUNTY TREASURER:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Moore, to approve the monthly report of County Treasurer, Ad S. Rogers for the month of August, 1947. Motion carried unanimously.

IN THE MATTER OF SETTING TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1947:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins, Seconded by Commissioner Moore to set the County Tax Levy for the year 1947 on the One Hundred Dollar valuation as follows:

IN THE MATTER OF REPAIRING COURT HOUSE ROOF:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the County Judge be instructed and empowered to advertise for competitive bids to repair the roof on the Court House. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF ENTERING INTO CONTRACT WITH U.S. GOVERNMENT RENTING OFFICES FOR RECRUITING:

On this the 8th day of September, 1947 at a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with all members present, came on to be considered the advisability of entering into a contract with the United States Government for renting to the Army Recruiting Service two rooms on the fourth floor of the Court House. Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and Seconded by Commissioner Ponder that the County Judge be directed and authorized to enter into a rental contract with the Army Recruiting Service for the renting of two rooms on the 4th floor of the Court House for a term of 1 year beginning July 1, 1947 through June 30, 1948 in consideration of the sum of \$180.00. Upon being put to a vote, said motion carried unanimously.
