IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Moore to approve the monthly accounts as same appear of record in Volume 8, Minutes of Accounts Allowed. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING COUNTY TREASURER'S MONTHLY REPORT:

Motion was made by Commissioner Moore and seconded by Commissioner Jones to approve the monthly report of Ad S. Rogers, County Treasurer for the month of November, 1947. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING FUNDS ON CONDEMNATION SUIT:

Whereas on November 17, 1947 a Jury of View in a condemnation proceedings on proposes farm to market highway No. 71 in Titus County, Texas, assessed as damages and gave to Robert D. Harper, Lois Davis Harper and husband, R. H. Harper and Mary Hinton Davis, owners of land through which said road runs, the sum of \$40.00, and whereas subsequent thereto the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas did in all things approve the Jury of Views report; therefore, in order to pay over the money to the parties entitled thereto, Motion made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner that the County Treasurer be directed to withdraw the sum of \$40.00 from the right of way fund and deposit said sum in a special account in the names of the parties hereto and that upon demand or notice the Treasurer be directed to pay over to the parties said sum of money. Upon being put to a vote, said motion unanimously carried.

On this the 8th day of December, 1947 came on to be heard before the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, at its Regular December term of the year 1947 the application of E. C. Russell and 7 other freeholders of Precinct No. One, Titus County, Texas, to discontinue a part of a certain public road located in Precinct No. Three, in Titus County, Texas.

It appearing to the Court that Notice of this application has been given as required by law by the posting of a copy of the application at the Courthouse door of Titus County, Texas, and at two other public places in the vicinity of the above mentioned road for at least twenty (20) days prior to this date, and it appearing to the Court that it would be to the best interest of the public, and that the public interest would be best served by discontinuing a part of said road.

It is therefore the order, judgment and decree of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas that a part of a certain public road located in Precinct No. One be discontinued and the beginning and termination of that portion of said road to be discontinued being as follows:

Being in the James F. Box Survey and beginning at the SE corner of a tract of land out of said survey owned by N. W. Presley - Running thence West with the SB line of N. W. Presley's land and Guy Traylor's land and the NB line of E. C. Russell's land to where said road intersects State Highway No. 49 at the NW corner of land owned by E. C. Russell.

Motion having been made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Moore, that the above order be passed, the said motion carried unanimously.
