IN THE MATTER OF SELLING DRAGLINE:

Whereas on the 8th day of December, 1947, the Commissionera Court of Titus County, Texas, verbally authorized the County Judge to sell one dragline belonging to the County for the sum of \$4,000.00 cash and whereas, on the 16th day of December, 1947 the County Judge did sell said dragline to Bill Moore of Dallas County, Texas for said sum of \$4,000.00; therefore, motion made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Moore that the action of the County Judge in selling said equipment be in all things confirmed. Motion unanimously carried.

There being no further business before the Court, motion made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Moore to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
