IN THE MATTER OF RAISE IN COMPENSATION OF COUNTY OFFICIALS:

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 28th day of July, 1948, at a special session of the Commissioners Court with all members present came on to be considered the advisability of raising the compensation of the County Officials of Titus County, as provided by law, and it appearing to the Court that the financial condition of Titus County and the high cost of living justifies such a raise;

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, be compensated in the additional amount of 25% as authorized by Article 3891, Section A, Vernon Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, effective July 1, 1948.

The above motion made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Ponder and upon being put to a vote unanimously carried.

There being no further business before the Court, Motion made by Commissioner Mankins and Seconded by Commissioner Ponder to adjourn. Motion carried.
