living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advances of living cost. And the Court deems that the salary should be increased \$40.00 per month, or an increase of \$450.00 per

year, making a salary of\$1080.00 per year, or \$310.00 per month, commencing August 1st. 1949. and to be apportioned and proreta among the 5 counties on a per month basis as follows: Camp County - - - -Franklin County - - -

Marion County - -Morris County - - - -Titus County
