 IN THE MATTER OF RAISING SALARY OF COURT REPORTER:

Mt. Pleasant, Texas,  
 August 1st, 1949

WHEREAS the Official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, J. R. Redfearn of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, is at present drawing a salary of \$3600.00 per year, (or \$300.00 per month) apportioned among the five counties of the District, and

WHEREAS, due to the high prices of food commodities and other increase in the cost of living, the present salary is not in keeping with the advances of living cost. And the Court deems that the salary should be increased \$40.00 per month, or an increase of \$480.00 per year, making a salary of \$4080.00 per year, or \$340.00 per month, commencing August 1st, 1949, and to be apportioned and prorata among the 5 counties on a per month basis as follows:
