IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING CLYDE M. HOWARD, DEPUTY COUNTY SHERIFF FOR DECEMBER, 1949:
 Acting upon a request from Sheriff Coy M. Coker a motion was made by R. W. Jones that Clyde M. Howard be employed as a deputy for the month of December at \$150.00 per month. The motion was seconded by Eugene Mankin and was unanimously adopted.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING TIME WARRANTS HELD BY THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK, Mt. Pleasant, Texas:
 A motion was made by Commissioner Mankin that lists of warrants held by The First National Bank be taken up and paid out of the Road and Bridge Funds of each precinct that were owing them. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ponder and was adopted.
