On this the 9th day of January, 1950, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, convened in regular session at a Regular Term thereof at the Courthouse in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

at which time, the County Judge presented for consideration an order:

Commissioner Eugene Mankins moved that the order be passed. The motion was seconded by Commissioner J. Q. Roper and was adopted by the following vote:

AYES: Commissioners Jones, Roper, Mankins and Ponder.

NOES: None.

The Judge announced that the order had been passed. The order is as follows:

WHEREAS, heretofore, to-wit, on the 10th day of October, 1949, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, passed an order authorizing the issuance of TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS, dated November 1, 1949, bearing 4-1/4% interest per annum, numbered 1 to 135, inclusive, in the denomination of \$1,000 each, aggregating \$135,000.00, and maturing on November 1st, \$3,000 in each of the years 1956 and 1957; \$2,000 in 1958; \$5,000 in each of the years 1959 to 1964, inclusive; \$7,000 in each of the years 1965 to 1969, inclusive; \$8,000 in each of the years 1970 to 1974, inclusive; \$7,000 in each of the years 1975 and 1976; and \$8,000 in 1977; and a tax has been levied sufficient in amount for the payment of said warrants according to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas, which warrants were duly authorized to be issued for the purpose of paying claims to be incurred in purchasing right-of-way for public roads in the County, and incidental expenses in connection therewith, constructing permanent road and bridge improvements in the County, and purchasing road machinery and equipment for use on the roads of said County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the passage of said order of October 10, 1949, certain claims have been incurred in constructing permanent road and bridge improvements in the County and purchasing road machinery and equipment for use on the roads of said County; and,

WHEREAS, said claims have been duly approved by the County Judge and audited and allowed by the Commissioners Court and have been found and determined to be valid claims against said Titus County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, claims in the aggregate amount of \$58,872.95 have been duly and legally transferred and assigned to the James C. Tucker & Company, Austin, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, it was provided in said order above referred to that said warrants above described should be executed, issued and delivered in payment of claims duly approved by the County Judge and audited and allowed by the Commissioners Court, and that said Commissioners Court in auditing and allowing said claims should designate the numbers of warrants to be delivered to evidence said claims so that the proceedings of this Court shall show to whom each of said warrants was delivered and the purpose for which same was delivered;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

I.

That the following claims heretofore approved by the County Judge and audited and allowed by the Commissioners Court incurred in constructing permanent road and bridge improvements in the County and purchasing road machinery and equipment for use on the roads of said County be and the same are hereby approved and allowed:

That the assignment of claims to JAMES C. TUCKER & COMPANY, AUSTIN, TEXAS, be and the same is hereby approved and allowed.

III.

That in accordance herewith and with the order of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, adopted on October 10, 1949, there shall be executed and delivered to JAMES C. TUCKER & COMPANY, AUSTIN, TEXAS, "TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS," numbers 76 to 135, inclusive, for \$1,000.00 each, aggregating \$58,000.00, evidencing the indebtedness due by Titus County, Texas, to said James C. Tucker & Company, as assignees of said claims; and that the excess of \$672.95 as shown by said list of claims be carried forward to the next exchange of claims for warrants.

IV.

The County of Titus having received full value and consideration for the warrants hereinabove described, the County Treasurer is hereby authorized and instructed to register said warrants, and after registration thereof, to deliver the same to said James C. Tucker & Company, and the County Judge, County Clerk and County Treasurer, are hereby authorized to

execute such other and further instruments, certificates or statements as shall be necessary, convenient or appropriate to reflect the entire validity of said warrants.

V.

It is further ordered that the above order take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

Commissioner J. R. Ponder introduced an order and made a motion that it be adopted.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Eugene Mankins. The motion, carrying with it the adoption of the order, prevailed by the following vote:

AYES: Commissioners JONES, ROPER, MANKINS and PONDER.

NOES: None.

The County Judge announced that the order had been finally passed. The order is as follows:

AN ORDER

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO GIVE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE ROAD AND BRIDGE REFUNDING BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$58,000.00, BEARING INTEREST AT A RATE NOT TO EXCEED FOUR AND ONE-FOURTH (4-1/4%) PER CENT PER ANNUM, AND MATURING SERIALLY, THE MAXIMUM MATURITY THEREOF TO BE NOT LATER THAN THIRTY-FIVE (35) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING A LIKE AMOUNT OF TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS, DATED NOVEMBER 1ST, 1949.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, has heretofore passed an order authorizing the issuance of TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS, dated November 1, 1949, Nos. 1 to 135, inclusive, in the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, aggregating \$135,000.00, bearing 4-1/4% interest per annum, and maturing on November 1st, \$3,000 in each of the years 1956 and 1957; \$2,000 in 1958; \$5,000 in each of the years 1959 to 1964; inclusive; \$7,000

in each of the years 1965 to 1969, inclusive; \$8,000 in each of the years 1970 to 1974, inclusive; \$7,000 in each of the years 1975 and 1976; and \$8,000 in 1977; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court deems it advisable and to the best interest of Titus County, Texas, to cancel not exceeding \$68,000.00 outstanding warrants of the above described issue by the issuance of refunding bonds in lieu thereof; and,

WHEREAS, it is now proper that the County give notice of its intention to issue said refunding bonds;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That the County Judge be and he is hereby authorized and directed to give notice, as required by Chapter 163, Acts of the Regular Session of the Forty-second Legislature of Texas, 1931, of the intention of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, to issue ROAD AND BRIDGE REFUNDING BONDS of said County, in an amount not exceeding \$68,000.00, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four and one-fourth (4-1/4%) per cent per annum, and maturing serially, with a maximum maturity not to exceed thirty-five (35) years from their date, for the purpose of canceling, refunding and in lieu of a like amount of TITUS COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE WARRANTS, dated November 1, 1949.

2. That the notice of intention to issue said bonds shall provide for the passage of the order authorizing the issuance of said refunding bonds at the regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, on February 13, 1950.
