IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING ACCOUNTS:

Dear Judge Mason:

As per our agreement approved by the Commissioners of Titus County when I appeared before the Commissioners sitting as a Board of Equalization of Titus County, on September 8, 1950, in your office at Mt. Pleasant, Texas:

We will withdraw our protest placed on our 1950 rendition and pay on the rendition amount of \$269,920, plus \$15,000, making a total of \$284,920, for tax valuation for Titus County for the year 1950, as a means of helping the county over the financial difficulty for the year 1950 as explained by you and the Commissioners. It is agreed that the Commissioners as such and as a Board of Equalization agrees to accept the rendition of St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas for 1951 in the amount of \$269,920, as valuation for tax purposes in Titus County for the year 1951, and being the same amount as rendered in 1950 and you agree that this shall be the valuation for tax purposes fixed by the Board.
