BE IT REMEMBERED That the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met in Special Session on December 5, 1950, at the Court House of Titus County, in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING PROPERTY FOR COUNTY HOSPITAL:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and Seconded by Commissioner Ponder that the property of Mrs. J. H. Goates consisting of approximately 5½ acres be accepted as the site for the Titus County Hospital and also that the whole 11 acres be improved or levelled off by the County. Motion was unanimously adopted.

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING OFFER OF BROWN & RUSSELL FOR LEGAL WORK IN REGARD TO TITUS COUNTY HOSPITAL:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roper and Seconded by Commissioner Jones to accept the offer of Brown & Russell to do the necessary legal work in preparing the deeds and examination of title of the hospital site. Motion was unanimously adopted.

There being no further business before the Court, Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Mankins to adjourn. Motion carried.
