IN THE MATTER OF ENTERING INTO CONTRACT WITH FRED AVERY FOR GRAVEL

Motion was made by Commissioner Jones and seconded by Commissioner Roper to enter into a contract between Titus County and Mr. Fred Avery to use gravel from his land at .30 cents load to be used in the next two years. This gravel to be used by all Commissioners if they need it. A payment of \$200.00 is paid in advance and will be deducted from the first gravel used. All voted "Aye" motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the Court, Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Mankins to adjourn. Motion carried.
