IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING MONTHLY ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Roper and seconded by Commissioner Jones to approve the monthly accounts as same appear of record in Warrant Book No. 2. Motion carried.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICERS MONTHLY EXPENSE ACCOUNTS:

Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Mankins to approve the officers monthly expense accounts as follows:

IN THE MATTER OF RAISING SALARIES OF COUNTY OFFICIALS & DEPUTIES, & OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES:

Upon the recommendation of the County Auditor to raise all County Officials and Commissioners, County Agent, Home Demonstration Agent in the amount of \$250.00 per year. The deputies of the County Clerk and Tax Assessor-Collector to receive a raise of \$200.00 per year and the office deputy of the Sheriff be raised \$120.00 per year as well as the secretary of the County Agent and Home Demonstration Agent be allowed the same. Motion was made by Commissioner Mankins and seconded by Commissioner Jones that the above recommendation be accepted and adopted, and upon being put to a vote carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the Court, Motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and seconded by Commissioner Mankins to adjourn. Motion carried.
