TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY:

We, the undersigned freeholders in Precinct No. 2, Titus County, Texas, represent to and petition the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, to make and enter an order discontinuing a public road situated in said precinct as follows:

Being a road situated about 10 miles Northwest of Mt. Pleasant known as the Bridges Chapel and Daphne Road. The part to be closed is at the Schultz farm northwest through Henry Mason property and which is about a mile in distance.

This petition is presented under and by virtue of Article #6705, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas.

TO THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF TITUS COUNTY, TEXAS:

The undersigned freeholders, residing in Precinct No. 1, Titus County, Texas, and in the vicinity of the road hereinafter mentioned, hereby petition the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas to discontinue a portion of a road to-wit:

To discontinue that portion of the Old State Highway from Mt. Pleasant to Pittsburg that lies between the North Boundary line of lands owned by the Estate of John W. Hargrove out of the Rebecca Kirk Survey, and that county road running East and West across said old Highway, which is at a distance of approximately 200 yards South of the North Boundary line of the Hargrove property, the section of said old highway which we petition to be discontinued as a public road being approximately 200 yards in length and is not used either as a mail route or school bus route.

We further represent that in the event the above portion of the said road is closed, that no person will be inconvenienced inasmuch as there are other and adequate roads and highways in the area that serve the traveling public and are used by the traveling public in lieu of the portion desired to be closed.
