IN THE MATTER OF CLOSING ROAD IN PRECINCT NO. 4:

PUBLIC ROAD NOTICE FOR CLOSING OF ROAD:

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED 25 freeholders, residing in the precincts through which the following described proposed Road will run, hereby give notice, according to law, that on the 20th day of July 1953, we will petition the Honorable Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, for closing of a Public Road in said County, App. 20 feet in width, having its points of beginning and termination, course and intermediate points as follows:

Commencing at Ross McElhany's, going south to the Miller house or from the Mt. Pleasant and Cason Road South through the D. H. Snodgrass farm now owned by R. P. White and his wife, to a Public Road extending east and west from Mayberry Flats

IN THE MATTER OF SURPLUS LATERAL FUNDS:

Dear Sir:

On September 1 we will credit your lateral road account with \$23,011.21 which represents your county's share of the surplus as of August 31. Of this amount we will credit the right-of-way portion of your road debt with \$-0- and your sinking fund with \$785.97. After this has been done there will remain a balance of \$22,225.24 which will be returned to your county for the construction or improvement of your lateral roads.

Before these funds can be forwarded to you it is necessary that we have an order from your Commissioners' Court requesting that we return this amount to the county and stating in the order the purpose for which this money will be used.

At a called meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, there came on to be considered the disposition of available lateral road funds of Titus County, Texas, now being held by the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness, Austin, Texas, in the approximate amount of \$22,225.24; and whereas, it appearing that Titus County use said sum of money for the improvement of its lateral roads and a request for said sum of money for the improvement of its lateral roads and a request for said sum of money should be made to the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness to forward same to Titus County. Whereupon a motion was made by Commissioner Ponder and Seconded by Commissioner Banks that The Board of County and District Road Indebtedness be requested to forward funds to Titus County to be used for lateral road improvement and when received should be in a separate fund to be known as Titus County Road Improvement Fund. Upon being put to a vote, by the County Judge, the motion carried unanimously and was declared adopted.

There being no further business before the court, motion was made by Commissioner Benka and Seconded by Commissioner Roper to adjourn. Motion carried.

The above and foregoing minutes were read and approved this the 31st day of July, 1953.
