On this the 17 day of August, 1953, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, convened in special session, at the regular meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at Mt.

collect in each year for a period of aix (5) years from the date of said election, county taxes da follows:

Not exceeding thirty three Cents (33%) on the \$100.00 valuation, in any one year, for County purposes:

Not exceeding twenty six Cents (26/) on the \$100.00 valuation, in any one year, for roads and bridges:

Not exceeding four Gents (4/) on the \$100.00 valuation, in any one year, to supplement the jury fund of the Gounty; and

Not exceeding seventeen Cents (17¢) on the \$100.00 valuation, in any one year, for the erection of public buildings and other permanent improvements?"

And it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held after due notice had been given, and that the said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 234 valid and legal votes, of which number there were contained.

"FOR RE-ALLOCATION OF COUNTY TAXES" . . . . . . . . . . . 206 votes.

(... IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECLARED by the Commissioners Court of Titus County,
Texas, that the proposition so submitted was sustained by a majority of the resident qualified
property taxpaying voters, who owned taxable property in said County and who had duly rendered
the same for taxation, voting at said election, and that the Commissioners Court of said
County is authorized to lavy and collect the taxes as set out in said proposition.
